Dear Parents/Carers,

Our No.1 priority is the safety and health of children, parents and staff

Thank you for your continued support in these strange and challenging times. Thank you for supporting your children with their home learning. Thank you for social distancing and keeping off the school premises. (This means not coming past the school gates and not walking through the school car park.)

Children of key workers

As you know, throughout the 10-week COVID-19 lockdown Christ Church stayed open as a “Childcare Hub” for vulnerable children and the children of key workers (especially NHS staff).

The Government says that every school must still make it a priority to keep places open for the children of key workers (especially NHS staff). To do this, we have had to offer key-worker children part-time places that match their parents’ shifts. (This is why some “learning bubbles” are full at some times and less busy at other times.)

Bubbles for Nursery, Reception and Year 1 children

Then, on 1 June 2020, we followed Government guidance and opened up places for other children in Nursery, Reception and Year 1. We did this by running small “learning bubbles”. These “bubbles” have staggered start and finish times and do not mix during the school day.

We want to do something special for Year 4

This will not be easy to organise, but we do know that for the Year 4 children themselves it is important that they get a chance to come back to say their goodbyes and to celebrate the end of their time at Christ Church.

This will have to be in a socially distanced way. It will have to be in “bubbles” and it will probably be part-time and for just a few sessions before the long Summer Holiday. As soon as we have more details, we will be in touch with parents/carers of Year 4 children.

Would you like your Nursery, Reception or Year 1 child to join our waiting list?

Because (for the reasons already mentioned) spaces are limited, and because we would like to be able to offer our Year 4 children some time with their staff, we cannot say “Yes” to every parent/carer who wants their Nursery, Reception or Year 1 child to come back to school from this point on. But we do have a waiting list.
