Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents, Carers and Friends of Christ Church,

Forgiveness is one of our five core Christian values

At Christ Church we talk about, encourage and celebrate forgiveness whenever and wherever we can.

Forgiveness is at the heart of the Christian message for good reason. It has the power to set people free from bitterness, anger and hatred. It can free people from revenge, retaliation and ongoing feuds. It allows people to get on with their lives ... to make friends ... to live in peace. Ultimately, forgiveness is a healthy choice to make.

Forgiveness is an important part of the "restorative justice" approach to managing behaviour. When one child hurts or upsets another child at Christ Church, a sincere apology ("I'm very sorry I hurt you") is followed by forgiveness ("I forgive you, but I don't want you to do that again").
